\$300-\$450/day, \$40-\$65/hour (2 hour minimum)

Reservations available for full days only. 7 Days In advance and will only be held until 9AM.

All boats require 2 hour minimum rental. Rates do not include fuel. Life jackets and safety equipment are provided. Rental hours are 8AM to 7PM daily, May 15 thru October 1st. A \$250 cash or credit card damage deposit is required on ALL reservations. All renter operators must be at least 18 years of age.
