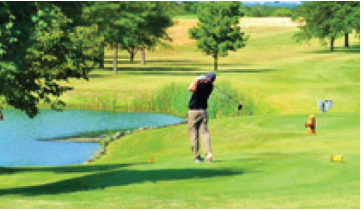




Fantle Memorial Park

G.A.R. Hall Art Gallery

This beautifully preserved 1887 Civil War building is home to Yankton Area Arts and provides a charming setting for art exhibits and events. The Grand Army of the Republic (G.A.R.) built the hall as the Phil Kearney Post No. 7, a meeting place for Union veterans and their auxiliary.

Gavins Point Dam

Gavins Point Dam, located on the Missouri River, was completed in 1957 as part of the Pick-Sloan Plan. The dam and power plant are operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Visit the viewing platform on the north side of the spillway, and Lewis and Clark Visitor Center on the hill north of the spillway. Check website for power plant tour availability.

Gavins Point National Fish Hatchery & Aquarium

Built in 1960 on the Missouri River, the hatchery has produced 5 billion+ fish for release. Watch fish and turtles swim within 13 tanks. Learn about the work of the hatchery. Aquarium open daily May 1 - Labor Day 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. Hatchery open year round.
