Ice House

Built in 1928 by John Keller, the Ice House was the first artificial ice plant in the area. Shortly after Prohibition, beer was sold there, and it became a fixture of Yankton. It is one of the only bars in the country with carhop service. However, most people prefer to sit on the "dock" in front of the Ice House while enjoying a beverage and partake in the tradition of smashing empty bottles against the brick wall beneath it. The Ice House has made Thrillist.com's "Best Dive Bars in America" and is a must-see.

Jack McCall Historical Sites

Yankton hosted the trial and hanging of the notorious Jack McCall for the murder of Wild Bill Hickok. Look for the plaque that marks McCall's 1877 hanging site at the intersection of Hwy. 81 & Hwy. 50. A proper headstone was set at the burial site in 2017 and can be found on the border of Sacred Heart Cemetery and the Yankton City Cemetery.

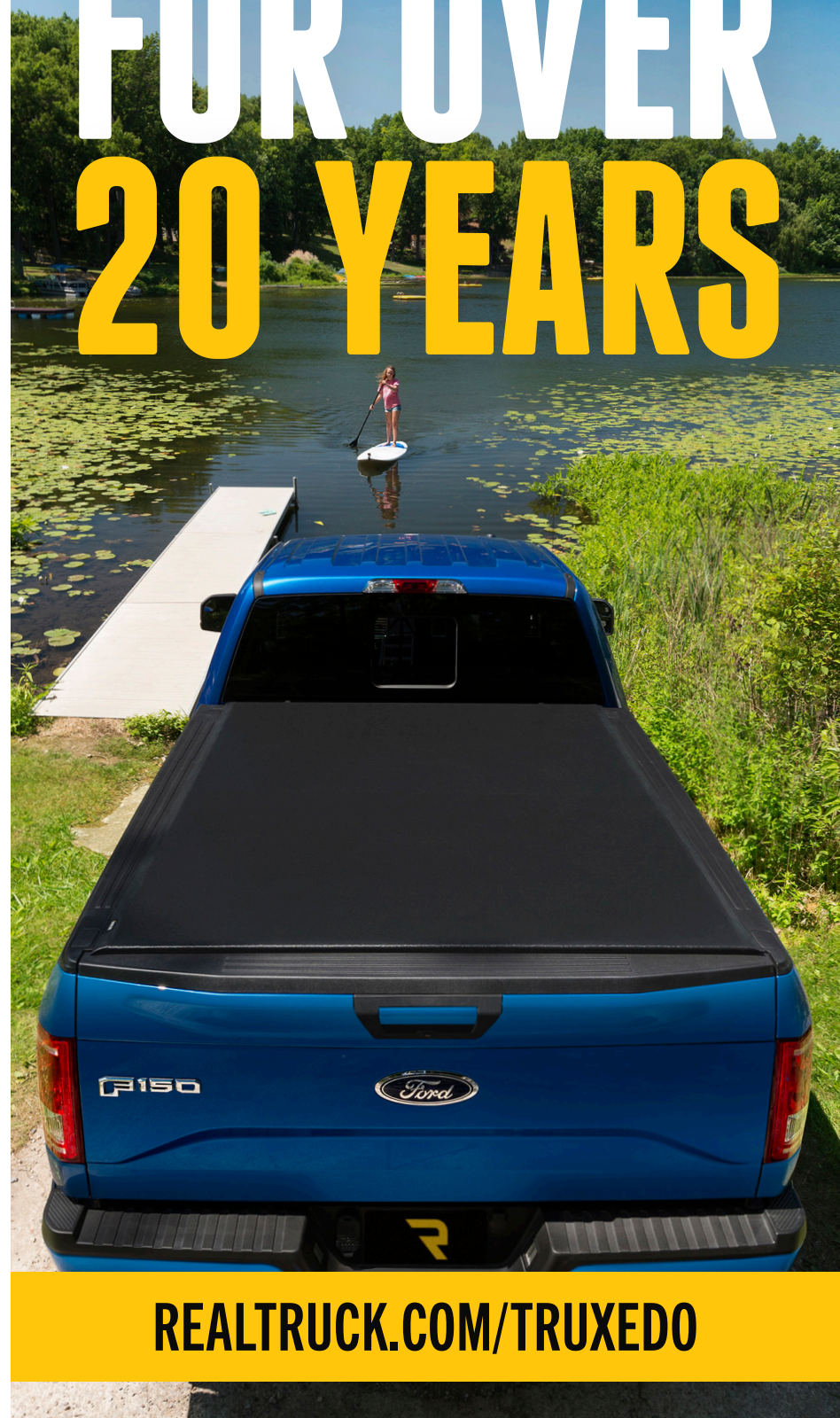
Karttrax Family Fun Park
